



Frequently Asked Questions

I'm not an elite swimmer, can I join in?

The swim is open to anyone who wants to give it a go.

What do I need for the swim?

Yourself, togs, goggles and wetsuits are optional.

How much is the entry fee?

Where does the swim start/finish?

Check out the course map on our web site. The swim starts and finishes on Mudjimba Beach near the Mudjimba Surf Life Saving Club.

What time does it start?

The swim commences at Mudjimba from 7.30am. Swimmers are to register between 5.45am and 7.15am. Registration will be located on the grassed area on the beachside of the Surf Club.

When is the Swim on?

The swim is held on Saturday 8th October 2022

What are the wave times?

Females: 7.30am

Males: 7.33am

Fins: 7.36am

Where do I enter?

Entries open on the 20th Jan 2022

What is the minimum age to participate?

15

Can I wear a wet suit?

Yes, wetsuits are optional.

Can I wear flippers?

There will be a flipper category at the event. Please ensure you register under this category if you want to wear flippers.

What if the event is cancelled due to weather conditions?

To ensure this event takes place in 2022 we have a contingency plan for the October 8, 2022 event. If the weather conditions at Mudjimba are too rough the swim will take place at Mooloolaba with an equally unique element to the swim.

What do I do if I need to cancel my registration?

The following refund fees are applicable for cancellations, depending on when the request is received.

- Refund of 75% up to 5pm, 3rd March 2022
- Refund of 50% up to 5pm, 10th March 2022
- Refund of 25% up to 5pm, 31st March 2022
- No Refunds after 30th June 2022 (extended from 31st March 2022)

Where can I park?

There is a parking area located south of the Surf Club plus plenty of street parking.
